Fabric Care Instructions, protected by Nano-Tex*

For the best results, remove spills and stains from fabrics as soon as possible. Spills and stains that go unnoticed for a period of time can be addressed successfully with the following procedures.

Liquid spills

Clean liquid spills with a dry absorbent clean cloth. Gently blot spill immediately while spill is still fresh. Don't rub. If needed, wipe off with clean water and a dry clean cloth.

Semi-solid spills

Clean semi-solid spills working with a dry absorbent clean cloth in a circular motion from the sides of the spill/stain. Change the cloth surface frequently until the spot has been transferred off of the fabric and onto the cloth. (Try to avoid pressing the spill or spreading the stain, best results will be achieved by working to "lift" the spot off the fabric.) If needed, wipe off with clean water and a dry clean cloth.

Stubborn stains

If a spill does not come off with water and a dry clean cloth, add a mild detergent mixed with water and repeat working the stain in a circular motion. Mild detergents such as Sport Wash®, Tide® Free, or Cheer® Free are recommended and should be used in a very small quantity for best results. Remove soap residue with water and a clean dry cloth.

Really stubborn stains

If a stain remains, a solvent may be used. Recommended solvents include odorless mineral spirits, dry cleaning fluid (perchloroethylene), or Fantastik® Orange Action™ All Purpose Cleaner. Again use a very small quantity of solvent to yield the best results. Remove all solvent residue with a clean dry cloth.

Additional Advice

If you don't feel like cleaning it yourself, companies including ServPro and ServiceMaster are available in most areas to tackle fabric spills and stains. Please provide these cleaning instructions to the service provider for the best results. Should you hire a service provider to perform a general cleaning of your upholstered furniture, recommend they follow the "stubborn stains" instructions above and perform a general warm water rinse and extraction. Detergents should be rinsed out thoroughly.

Dry cleaning of Nano-Tex treated fabrics is not recommended as a residue is left behind in the process that will act to mask the Nano-Tex protection.
